






## Insight 1 Number One Priority: Communication

This is even seen as more important than protecting employees' health.




Question: What do you expect your company's leadership to do to prepare for the possible impact of the Coronavirus? (please select all that apply)

When asked who at their company is ultimately responsible for ensuring the business is prepared for the impacts of COVID-19, **employees assign ultimate responsibility to the CEO.** 




Question: Who do you believe should be responsible for ensuring your company is prepared for the possible impact of the Coronavirus? (please select all that apply)

At the moment, employees' are most concerned about protecting the health of their families and the possibility of broader long-term economic fallout.




Question: Which of the following is your BIGGEST concern about the corona virus?

While most employees believe their company is keeping pace or ahead of peer companies in addressing the virus, one in three want their employer to do more.




Question: Compared to other companies, do you believe your company is doing more or less to prepare for the possible impacts of the Coronavirus?
