AND UPON the summons issued by the Company on 23 February 2023 seeking an adjournment of the Petition (the **Adjournment Application**)

AND UPON reading the First Affirmation of Wendi He made on 24 February 2023 provided in signed but unsworn form, and the exhibit thereto in support of the Adjournment Application

AND UPON reading the supplemental skeleton argument filed by the Petitioner in opposition to the Adjournment Application

AND UPON hearing counsel for the Petitioner and the Company

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Adjournment Application is dismissed.
- 2. The Company be wound up in accordance with section 92(d) of the Companies Act.
- 3. Mr Jeffrey Stower of Teneo (Cayman) Limited, Ground Floor, Harbour Place, 103 South Church Street, PO Box 10245, George Town, Cayman Islands and Ms Chan Mei Lan of Teneo Asia Limited and 13F, Wyndham Place, 40-44 Wyndham Street, Central, Hong Kong be appointed as joint official liquidators of the Company (the "JOLs").
- 4. The JOLs are authorised to act jointly and severally in their capacity as liquidators of the Company.
- 5. The JOLs shall not be required to give security for their appointment.
- 6. The JOLs are authorised to do any act or thing considered by them to be necessary or desirable in connection with the liquidation of the Company and the winding up of its affairs in the Cayman Islands or elsewhere.

- 7. The JOLs are authorised to take any such action as may be necessary or desirable to obtain recognition of their appointment in any other relevant jurisdiction and to make applications to the courts of that jurisdiction for such purpose.
- 8. The JOLs are at liberty to meet all disbursements reasonably incurred in connection with the performance of their duties out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
- 9. The JOLs are at liberty to apply generally to the Court to make such orders for regulating the future conduct of the affairs of the Company as the Court shall see fit.
- 10. The JOLs are authorised to exercise within and outside the Cayman Islands any of the powers conferred on them by the Court pursuant to Section 110(2) and Part II of the Third Schedule of the Companies Act without further sanction or intervention of the Court.
- 11. The JOLs have the power to appoint agents in Hong Kong, the Cayman Islands, the People's Republic of China and elsewhere to do any business contemplated by this order which they are unable to do themselves or which can more conveniently be done by an agent.
- 12. The JOLs are at liberty to appoint counsel, attorneys, and/or any other professional advisors, whether in the Cayman Islands or elsewhere, as they may consider necessary to advise and assist them in the performance of their duties and on such terms as they may think fit and to remunerate them out of the assets of the Company.
- 13. The remuneration and expenses of the JOLs shall be paid out of the assets of the Company in accordance with the Companies Act and the Insolvency Practitioners' Regulations, 2018.
